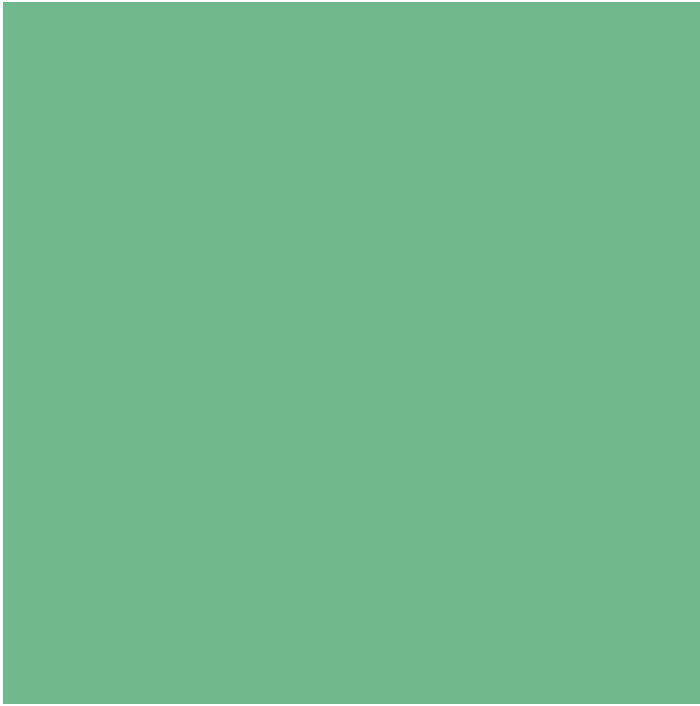

## FLOAT DISPOSAL AND RECYCLING

1. The first step in the recycling process is to collect the float material. This is done by using a float collection system that captures the float as it rises to the surface of the water.

2. Once collected, the float material is transported to a recycling facility where it is processed. The float is first broken down into smaller pieces, which are then washed and dried.
